Dear Friends,

I remember commenting to an Anglican colleague some years ago about how I find it strange that some people in our churches attend worship on Palm Sunday and again on Easter Day but never come to a service or devotional activity during Holy Week. His response was 'Philip, we'll make an Anglican of you yet!' I'm not sure why he thought that only Anglicans would want to observe Holy Week but, many years later, I'm still bemused by the same issue. It seems to me that to go from Palm Sunday to Easter Day without really engaging with the part of Jesus' story which we commemorate during Holy Week is a bit of a cop out. Of course we can engage with that part of the story personally and privately but, if we celebrate Palm Sunday and Easter with other Christians, then why is it less important to commemorate the crucifixion in the same way?

Hearing the story of Christ's passion can be a bit like watching a re-run of a favourite drama series or reading a favourite book for the umpteenth time. We know how the story ends. For those involved in the events of the first Easter there was no hope of resurrection. I hope that as we hear the passion and resurrection stories this year that there will be a freshness about them and that we'll be filled with wonder as we reflect on God's love for the world and the ultimate triumph of life over death.
