Dear Friends,

I am writing this on Bank Holiday Monday, May 5th, at the beginning of the week in which we are celebrating the 80th anniversary of VE day. We have been so fortunate. Since the end of WWII we have not had war in Europe until Russia invaded Ukraine, largely thanks to the existence of the UN, the EU and NATO. But other countries have faced war, frequently in the Middle East, and centred around Palestine.

It is ironic that the birthplace of Jesus, a place that is holy to the three Abrahamic religions, Judaism, Islam and Christianity, and where Jesus taught about the supremacy of love, should be a melting pot of dissension. And that is a gross understatement.

It is all too easy to become disillusioned. Governments throughout the world are wanting to spend more on weapons. I wonder what would happen if they were to put as much money and effort into working for peace.

The 1945 Methodist Service of Thanksgiving for use on the Cessation of Hostilities in Europe ends with this Choral Supplication, which was sung by the congregation, kneeling. It is as pertinent today as then:

God bless our native land!
May heaven's protecting hand
Still guard our shore:
May peace her power extend,
Foe be transformed to friend,
And Britain's rights depend
On war no more.

Nor on this land alone,
But be God's mercies known
From shore to shore:
Lord make the nations see
That men should brothers be,
And form one family
The wide world o'er.

As I cease working in the circuit, I ask God's blessing on you all. **Meg**.
